

Upcoming Semester Plan

During the Spring 2018 Semester, I will take two courses and work full-time as an educator. I am enrolled in LIS 5023: Management of Information and Knowledge Organizations and in LIS 5053: Information Users in the Knowledge Society.

LIS 5023 will expand my knowledge and skills of issues involved in effectively operating a knowledge-based institution. I also hope the course assists me in gaining management, leadership (Goal 3.2), and communication (Goal 2.2) skills in order to successfully operate a library. I feel this class will benefit me in meeting objectives that I have due to my lack of experience in library settings.
